- Entries are accepted in order of postmark.
- Overnight or certified mail must be sent “No Signature Required”.
- No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery.
- A \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.
- Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Returned checks or unpaid entries do not constitute a valid entry.
- No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing day/time with the exception of bitches in season as listed in the section below under REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS.
- Juniors must provide an AKC Junior number to be eligible for class discount.
- An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog in a single class.
- Inquiries may be directed to the Trial Secretary.

HIGH IN TRIAL and HIGH COMBINED

Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered (Buried, Container, Exterior, Interior) and qualify in each are eligible to win High in Trial. One High in Trial winner is chosen per level. There is not a separate High in Trial for the Novice A and Novice B Sections. High In Trial is determined by adding the team's fault across the elements. If there is a tie based on the lowest faults, the team's times across the element will be summed and the fastest finishing team will win. The High in Trial awards are not recorded by AKC. High Combined in Trial is the same as above including the HD element.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Dogs who are six (6) months of age or older and are registered with the AKC, have a AKC Limited Registration, have an AKC Canine Partners Listing, have a Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breed are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) pr AKC Canine Partners Listing must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate, provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind can participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirement of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge. Bitches in season MAY NOT participate. A refund of entry fees for bitches that come into season after the closing date/time may be obtained by notifying the Trial Secretary in writing no late than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Entries withdrawn for any reason, except bitch in season, after the closing date are eligible for a refund. Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Cancellation of entries must be in writing and received prior to the stated close of entries. A full refund will be issued.

CLASS TRANSFERS

A move up transfer may be requested if, according to the owner's record, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date/time of the trial in which the advanced entry has been made. A move down transfer may be requested if the owner mistakenly entered the dog in a higher level class for which it is not eligible. A lateral transfer may be requested if the owner mistakenly entered the dog in Noice A and is not eligible. The request for a class transfer must be submitted in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfer will be approved provided there is availability in the class.

NQ "WINE ABOUT IT" RAFFLE

For each Non-Qualifying run an exhibitor may write their name on a slip of paper to enter a drawing to win a bottle of wine. The recipient must be 21 years of age or older and present to win.

WAIT LIST

Little Rock Dog Training Club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries per trial will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, April 30th, 2025, at 6 pm. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on Wednesday, April 30th, 2025. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

CHECK-IN, STAGING AREA, BRIEFING, WARM-UP, RINGSIDE & HD

At check-in you will receive your armband number. EXHIBITORS MUST CHECK-IN EACH DAY ENTERED

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The Handler's Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A warm-up area the club shall designate a warm-up area. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

Ringside. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Handler Discrimination. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag, for the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs.

SITE INFORMATION

It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Integrity of searches. If anyone is found to be discussing a search before classes have ended, all parties in the discussion will be penalized with a "not qualified" NQ for all classes entered that day and will forfeit entry for subsequent days as well. For persons not entered, the Event Committee may ask those involved to leave.

CRATING WILL BE OUT OF CARS FOR ALL EXHIBITORS. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. RV Parking is NOT available at trial site. Crating space will be available to workers and judges only. XPENS ARE NOT ALLOWED. The event site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Little Rock Dog Training Club and the Arkansas Waterfowl Association will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

NO SMOKING or ALCOHOL is PERMITTED AT TRIAL SITE.

RUN ORDER Handler Discrimination will run first. Master and Novice will start first for each element and will follow with Excellent and Advanced. A final Schedule will be sent out before the trial. Final run order of the classes will be determined after the close to allow for judge workload balance and at the judge's discretion.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS SAFETY, BEHAVIOR & LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

PHOTOS & VIDEOS Exhibitors are welcome to photograph and/or video their own dogs either by another person or using a Go-Pro camera or the like as permitted by AKC. Exhibitors are encouraged to share their own dogs searching on social media and/or website upon completion of that day's trials. No person should post photos or videos of dogs they do not own without explicit permission from that dog's owner. Judges may photograph and/or video searches they are judging for the purpose of their own education. Judges' photos and/or videos may not be displayed or used for any purpose other than their own viewing without explicit permission of LRDTTC and the dogs owners. Similar penalties as explained in the section "Integrity of Searches" may be imposed for violation of photo/video rules. Photographers/Videographers authorized by LRDTTC to document its events may be present at these trials. You may decline their taking video or photos of you and/or your dog. **NO PHOTOS OR VIDEOS MAY BE POSTED, DISPLAYED OR SHOWN UNTIL AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE TRIALS**

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
